

Lesson One:

Holy Thursday

Holy Thursday is the Thursday before Easter which is part of the Holy Week. It commemorates the Washing of the Feet and Last Supper of Jesus Christ with the Apostles. Jesus washed his disciples' feet as a symbol of humility and His servanthood. Jesus said: If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. During the Last Supper Jesus Christ established the sacrament of Holy Communion prior to his arrest and crucifixion. It also commemorates His institution of the priesthood.

3. Which sacrament did we learn from the Last Supper?
